



Gallery 53 New Member Information & Application

Gallery 53 on Rocky Neck, a juried gallery run by members of the Rocky Neck Art Colony (RNAC), is centrally located between the Studio and Rudder restaurants at 53 Rocky Neck Avenue. *Gallery 53* is run like a co-operative, where all members share in the duties related to operating the gallery, but unlike a co-operative the members do not share in the expenses, profits or losses. The Rocky Neck Art Colony Galleries (the for-profit branch of non-profit RNAC) pays expenses, collects rent from artists, and takes a commission on artwork sold. Gallery 53 is open seasonally from the Friday before Memorial Day until mid-October, 10am to 6pm daily and until 8pm on Fridays and Saturdays.

Fees	\$25 Application Fee (fee waived if applied and paid last year) \$150 per <i>unit of space*</i> per season (due in May if accepted). New artists may apply for one or two units. RNACG takes 25% commission on work sold.

Jurors	A group of Gallery 53 members will select new members based on creativity, technical skill, marketability, presentation, and appropriateness for Gallery 53. Work that is very similar to an existing member's work may not be accepted. We will notify artists of our decision within two weeks of jurying.

**units of space* – 2D units (work hanging on the wall) are approximately 2 feet wide by 4 feet high*. 3D units (work on shelves, display cases or pedestals) are approximately 1 by 3 feet* of shelf space. 2D artists may also sell 5 unframed shrink-wrapped pieces per unit of space and up to 25 greeting cards or card sets. 3D artists may also sell up to 30 small items priced under \$25 that can be displayed on a free-standing rack or container.
